

Guidelines for Submission and Publication of Papers



The proceedings of the 10th International Conference on Life Cycle Management (LCM 2021) will be published in an online Open Access journal. All presenters are invited to submit their findings, which will be peer reviewed by the session chairs, by further scientists and editors of the LCM 2021.

Important Dates:

- Submission system opens after the conference: 11 September 2021
- Submission date: 30 September 2021
- Acceptance notification: 31 October 2021
- Deadline for final papers: 30 November 2021

The proceedings of the LCM 2021 will be:

- Peer reviewed
- Open Access
- Attribution of DOI Names and indexation to CrossRef®
- Indexation in main databases, including Scopus
- The copyright is retained by the author(s) under the Creative Commons Attribution license
- All online articles are published in color
- The quality of the PDFs and the common errors will be checked by the editorial secretary (random and/or incorrect symbols, figures or tables missing, wrong numbering, authors' affiliation missing)

About the Journal:

E3S Web of Conferences (e3s-conferences.org). E3S Web of Conferences is an Open Access publication series dedicated to archiving conference proceedings in all areas related to Environment, Energy and Earth Sciences.

Submission:

After the conference the editorial team will use a submission online tool, which will facilitate various steps (submission, reviewing and selection), and automates a number of exchanges between authors, reviewers and organizers. Each author will receive their log in credentials to the submission system (only submission from authors who attended the conference will be reviewed and published).

Instructions for authors:

Each submitted article must contain the findings and research presented at the LCM 2021. One author can provide not more than two papers. We recommend that authors read the Publishing Policies & Ethics (<https://www.e3s-conferences.org/about-the-journal/publishing-policies-ethics>), and use the guidelines (https://www.e3s-conferences.org/doc_journal/woc/e3sconf_editorial_guidelines.pdf) of the journal. We also request the authors to use the template to prepare their articles (format: 17x25 cm one column). The submitted paper:

- Has a min. of 4 and max. 6 pages (including figures, tables and references)
- Includes the submitted abstract and is related to the conference presentation or poster of the LCM 2021
- Papers are written in English (corrected by English Speaking person)

Standard editing means:

- Edit into proper British English without causing misinterpretations or rewriting for stylistic reasons
- Edit for grammar, clarity and consistency
- Spelling – Sentence structure check, English word choice, clarity, parallel structure, tone, voice, redundancy. A complex sentence or incomprehensible sentence can be subject to a query
- Grammar – Subject-verb agreement, article usage, prepositions, pronouns and determiners, adverbs and adjectives
- Punctuation – Commas, colons, semicolons, dashes, quotation marks, apostrophes
- Spelling consistency – In active/passive form, first/third person, present/past tense
