



Guide for poster creation

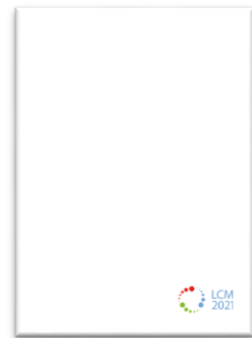
Since the poster presentation will take place exclusively in digital form via our conference platform, the creation of the document format, for example DIN A0, plays a subordinate role. However, if you want to use the poster for other purposes, you should still consider the document format. For the formal design, please follow the generally accepted rules regarding fonts, font size and text formatting. A balanced proportion of text and graphics as well as an appealing, reader-friendly color concept is also desirable.

By embedding a link on the conference platform, a document upload of one one-page PDF file and one video container format MP4 per poster presentation is possible. The integration is rounded off by video exchange and integrated chat function.

PDF file – mandatory:

- Portrait format (upright format)
- Maximum upload size is 5 MB
- Integration of the LCM 2021 logo, right in the bottom footer, minimum size 25% of page width with minimum distance to page margin of 5% each of page width/height to right/bottom
- File name: PosterLCM2021 - Abstract Number - Name of presenting author - First words of the title of the accepted abstract as poster.pdf

Please send the PDF file to abstract@lcm2021.org no later than 15 August 2021.

Video file – optional:

- MP4 video container format
 - Maximum length is 2 minutes
 - The video recording can be a still image (poster insertion) with sound or a short film with personal presentation of the poster
 - Integration of the LCM 2021 logo
 - File name: PosterLCM2021 - Abstract Number - Name of presenting author - First words of the title of the accepted abstract as poster (Video).mp4
- [e.g.: "PosterLCM2021 - 54321 - Matthias Fischer - LCA and LCC (Video).mp4"]

Uploading a video file for the poster presentation is an additional offer, but not a mandatory service for participation in the conference. If desired, please upload the video file to the following link <https://bit.ly/2TIFjP3> by 15 August 2021 at the latest.
